ORCHESTRA

All campers will participate in Orchestra.

CHAMBER MUSIC

You will have an opportunity to play in a small ensemble of other campers, and each group will be assigned to a coach from the faculty.

CONCERT on Sunday at 2:00 pm. Help your parents load your things into the car between 1:00—2:00. Then have them join us for a concert in the Dining Hall before heading home.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Cabins house up to eight campers with one or two chaperones per cabin. String Fling Faculty will serve as chaperones. Campers may request one roommate. We will do our best to honor roommate requests, but cannot guarantee to meet everyone's requests. Many cabins have bathrooms with toilet, sink and shower. If your cabin does not have a bathroom, you will have a short walk to a bath house. Cabins have bunks with mattresses.

FOOD

The food at Camp Hazen is excellent and plentiful, and the dining hall is inviting with a lakeside view. Healthy snacks are available 24 hours a day. Please remember: *No food or drink are allowed in the cabins at any time.* You may carry a water bottle.

REHEARSAL SPACE

Large group rehearsals for orchestra and world music will be held in the beautiful Lakeside room, which is attached to the Main Dining Hall. The Lakeside room has large windows overlooking the lake.

Chamber Music and practicing will be in cabins. Chamber groups are always supervised and everyone's personal property is secure. For this reason, campers need to always leave their cabins in a usable condition.

ACCEPTANCE

Acceptance to camp may be limited by needs for instrumentation in our ensembles, and all applications will be considered on a first come, first served basis. Campers agree to abide by all Camp Hazen YMCA and CT-ASTA rules. Unsafe behavior or disrespect toward any other camper or teacher or anyone else's property could result in immediate dismissal from camp.
